

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School Trips

We have had a busy half term of trips and visits: Year 3/4 went on a walk to Woodlesford canal to support their learning about UK waterways. Year 1/2 also went on a local area walk into Woodlesford as part of their local area geography topic.

Year 5/6 have also visited Leeds City Museum over the last two weeks where they took part in an Egyptians workshop. Two of the classes travelled into Leeds by train but a train strike meant that one class had to travel by coach. The children who travelled by train were a credit to us as they sensibly walked to the train station and through the city centre-there looked to be many tired faces on their return to school!

Y1 Phonics Check and Y4 Multiplication Check

During June, there are statutory checks that both Y1 children and Y4 children need to complete. Y1 pupils undertake their Phonic Screening Check between the 10th and 14th June. Any Y2 pupils who did not pass the check last year will also be reassessed.

Over the first two weeks of the half term, Y4 pupils will complete their multiplication checks.

As with all of the statutory checks that the school has to administer, we try to ensure that these are completed in in a low-pressure way and that they are not built up into something the children worry about. The results of both checks will be reported alongside your child's end of year report.
